

## Parish boundary with Ousden

As part of a county wide Community Governance Review being carried out by Suffolk, the location of the boundary between Ousden Parish Council and Dalham and Dunstall Green Parish Council is to be reviewed. As residents will be aware, the boundary is presently close to the southern end of Dunstall Green Road, close to Ousden, and the issue relates to whether it would be more appropriate for houses along Dunstall Green Road, currently forming part of the parish of Dalham and Dunstall Green, to become part of Ousden instead. Some 23 houses are affected by this review. The parish council will be seeking the views of those residents potentially affected prior to providing its response.
